CONDITIONS OF PLAY

These conditions of play may be altered by the HDRAGC Match Committee at their discretion.

1. FORMAT

- 1.1. The 2022 Coolalinga Woolworths Humpty Doo Open Championship is a tournament for men and women featuring stroke play played over 36 holes at Humpty Doo & Rural Area Golf Club.
- 1.2. There will be a limit of 112 players and entries close Thursday 12 May 2022 at 5pm unless filled prior.
- 1.3. Play will be on Saturday 14 May 2022 (Round 1) and Sunday 15 May 2022 (Round 2). The draw for each round will be available after 8pm on Thursday 12 May & Saturday 14 May on the club website www.humptydoogolfclub.com.au, on Facebook, or by phoning the club on (08) 8988 1118.
- 1.4. Round 1 of the championship will not be seeded. Players can expect a tee time as close as possible to the time nominated on the entry form. A seeded draw within grades (men's top eight and women's top four) will be conducted for round 2 of the championship. Seeded players must play in their seeded group to be eligible for the championship.
- 1.5. Prizes will be awarded for: Overall Champions: Men & Women; Overall Gross & Nett Winners: Men's A, B, & C Grades & Women; Overall Gross & Nett Runners Up: Men's A, B, & C Grades & Women; Daily Gross & Nett Winners: Men's A, B & C Grades & Women; Daily NTP's: Men & Women; Daily Long Drives: Men's A, B, & C Grades & Women; Hole-in-One Prize: First Player to score a Hole-in-One on the nominated hole.
- 1.6. The winning Men's and Women's player shall be the Humpty Doo Open Champion.
- 1.7. In the event of a tie for overall champion, or for gross winners in all grades, there will be a sudden death play-off on the 18th hole at the end of scheduled play on day 2, until a winner is determined.
- 1.8. Ties for the overall nett winners will be decided by countback.
- 1.9. There is no limit to the number of prizes won by any one player.

2. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

- 2.1. The championship committee for the event will be the Humpty Doo & Rural Area Golf Club (HDRAGC) captains and match committee.
- 2.2. The championship committee's decisions on matters affecting the championship shall be final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted within fifteen (15) minutes of the conclusion of the day's play.

3. RULES OF PLAY

- 3.1. The Rules of Golf, as adopted by the R&A Ltd, shall apply together with the Local Rules and Temporary Local Rules as drawn up by the championship committee.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1. Entries shall only be made by completing the entry form available on the HDRAGC website or at the Club bar.
- 4.2. The entry fee is detailed on the entry form.
- 4.3. Eligible players are amateurs who are a financial member of a recognised affiliated club in the country the player resides in, with a WHS or equivalent handicap at the time of play that does not exceed 36 for men and 45 for women.
- 4.4. Your starting handicap will remain locked in for the full championship.
- 4.5. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the championship committee. Any such entry shall be subject to a late entry fee of \$20 per player.
- 4.6. It is the sole responsibility of the entrant themselves to ensure that their entry is received prior to the closing time for entries.
- 4.7. In the event of cancellation, the HDRAGC is only liable to refund the entry fee.

5. MOTORISED TRANSPORT

- 5.1. The HDRAGC Championship Committee approves the use of motorized transport in the Humpty Doo Open.

6. PACE OF PLAY

- 6.1. Rule 5.6b of the Rules of Golf will be strictly enforced. See: <https://www.randa.org/en/rog/2019/pages/the-rules-of-golf>
- 6.2. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them without good reason will be considered out of position. Players deemed responsible for unreasonable delay of play will receive a one stroke penalty for the first breach, a two stroke penalty for the second breach, and disqualification for the third breach. If the player unreasonably delays play between two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

7. CODE OF CONDUCT

- 7.1. All entrants assent to be bound by Golf NT's Code of Conduct. This code is available via the Golf NT website: <http://www.golftnt.org.au/>

8. DRESS STANDARDS

- 8.1. Players and caddies must observe the dress standards and any course requirements of the HDRAGC.

9. DRAW AND STARTING TIMES

- 9.1. A draw for each day's play will be made by the Championship Committee. The draw for day 1 will be posted on the club website after 8:00pm on Thursday 12th May 2022.
- 9.2. The player must start at (and not before) his or her starting time established by the committee. Penalty for breach of Rule 5-3a will be applied if a player plays within five minutes before their starting time or arrives at their starting point, ready to play within five minutes after their starting time. A two stroke penalty applies for the first hole. Unless a change in starting time has been approved by the Championship Committee, the penalty for a player starting more than five minutes early, or more than five minutes late, is disqualification.
- 9.3. The Championship Committee has the power to amend the draw or substitute another player for any competitor who is not at the tee at the time appointed to play. It may also alter the starting time for any player.

10. GOLF BALLS

- 10.1. It will be obligatory for all competitors in the Championship to play with a ball that is listed in the current R&A and/or USGA Conforming Golf Balls. Penalty: Disqualification.

11. PRACTICE

- 11.1. Practice will not be permitted on the course between rounds of the Championship. Penalty: Disqualification.

12. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

- 12.1. For all play on this course, a player may obtain distance information by using a device (DMD) that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a DMD that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, a compass, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3 whether or not the features are actually used. Penalty for breach of rule 14-3: Disqualification.
